The System of Assessment of Students' Achievements in the Baccalaureate and Master's Degree Programmes of Tbilisi Theological Academy and Seminary Functioning under the Aegis of the Autocephalous Apostolic Orthodox Church of Georgia

Assessment of students' achievements in the Baccalaureate and Master's degree programmes of Tbilisi Theological Academy and Seminary, functioning under the aegis of the Autocephalous Apostolic Orthodox Church of Georgia, is carried out according to the system of 100 scores, which consists of midterm assessment (attendance, seminars, and presentations), and the final assessment:

The final examination is compulsory and every student who has gained no less than 11 scores in the midterm assessment is admitted to it.

The system of assessment comprises five positive assessments:
(A) Excellent - 91-100 scores;
(B) Very Good - 81-90 scores;
(C) Good - 71-80 scores;
(D) Satisfactory - $61-70$ scores;
(E) Acceptable - 51- 60 scores.

In the system of assessment, two negative ones are also considered:
(FX) Failed Examination - 41-50 scores, which means that the student is to further enhance his work on the subject, and is given one more chance to take the additional examination after having worked independently on the subject;
(F) Failed - 40 scores and less, which means that the student has not given enough attention to the study of the subject and he is to take it anew.

The final scores are not added to those acquired at the additional examination.
The score of the additional examination is the final score and it effects the final assessment of the academic year.

Taking into consideration the score acquired at the additional examination, in case of getting 0-50 as the final assessment, the student acquires F-0 scores.
